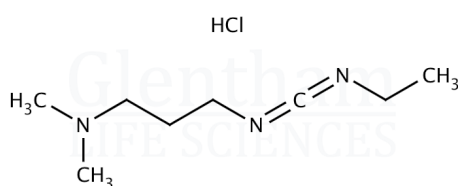

EDC hydrochloride, or EDAC, is a water-soluble carbodiimide derivative and coupling agent that catalyses amide and carboxylic ester formation. EDC is used in the synthesis of peptides, the modification of NMDA receptors and the preparation of immunoconjugates.

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
